DID YOU KNOW . . . EDUCATION IN THE PIONEER SETTLEMENT: By 1908 plans were being made to build a bigger school on land donated by Hugh and Claude McLachlin exclusively for “the use of a Roman Catholic Separate School” (site of Beer Store) Plans for the new school were drawn up by Rudolph Reinke of Eganville; construction was completed by Stephen Smith of Barry's Bay. The school was a grey concrete block building of two regular size classrooms with a smaller room added on in 1920. The school opened in 1915 with two teachers being responsible for the education of 80 students.
