During the month of the Holy Souls (November) there is a "Book of Life" placed at the vigil light stand. You are invited to list the names of your beloved dead and they will be prayed for at every mass during November.

AS WE have begun the Month of the Holy Souls, let us be fervent in our prayers for the souls of the faithful departed, especially those who have no one to pray for them. The catechism articulates this comforting belief of our faith: "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven". The consolation of our belief in the resurrection of the dead and the communion of the saints allows us to pray for those who have died: especially in the offering of the Sacrifice of the Mass, and our other prayers and acts of charity for them. In doing so we carry out a spiritual work of mercy and proclaim the saving work of Jesus' death and resurrection.

DID YOU KNOW . . . DEVELOPMENT OF THE VILLAGE OF BARRY'S BAY – The site for the village of Barry's bay began as a logging depot built by the McLaughlin Brothers, lumber barons of Arnprior, on the north shore of Kamaniskog Lake on the Madawaska River. The village originated as a one-street "Stopping Place" (1879) on the Opeongo Colonization Road. Greatly benefited by the logging operations on the Madawaska River, the village soon developed into a small settlement on "Blueberry Plains", and flourished from its location on J.R. Booth's Ottawa, Arnprior, and Parry Sound Railway (1894).
