VOCATIONS – Each person, by virtue of Baptism, has received a call to holiness. Our Vocations are lived out in marriage, the single state, priesthood and consecrated life. This year one couple will receive the Sacrament of Matrimony at St. Lawrence O'Toole. We give thanks for the many dedicated single persons who serve so generously as leaven within the world. Our diocese currently has two men in priestly formation: Rev. Michael Coyne from St. Francis Xavier Parish, who God willing will be ordained to the Sacred Priesthood this Spring. Every member of the parish has a responsibility to pray for vocations and encourage members in their consideration of the will of God in their lives.
