But the truth is that God transcends the lines we've drawn and the boundaries we've set up in order to keep on top of the many different aspects of our lives. God calls us to realize His hand in all things, His Spirit making all things whole and good, His vision of us as a human family united in His peace, justice and mercy. Dr. Martin Luther King said: "Cowardice asks the question, Is it safe? Expediency asks the question, Is it political? Vanity asks, Is it popular? But conscience asks the question, Is it right? There comes a time when one must take a position that's neither safe, nor political, nor popular, but he must make it because his conscience tells him that it is right."

**VOLUNTEERS:** This pandemic is lasting longer than most of us expected. To keep our church open we must be diligent in our sanitizing of the building after EVERY liturgy to keep all us safe. Consider staying after any mass to help with this important effort. If you can wipe, you are welcome AND needed.

**SACRAMENTS OF FIRST CONFESSION, HOLY COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION:**

What remains before us now is a unique challenge of developing a way to offer preparation for those desiring the sacrament of Reconciliation, Holy Eucharist and Confirmation in the months within the restrictions that we are facing. So as to assist in our discernment as how to best proceed, it would be very helpful to know how many parents are interested in having their child prepare for any of these sacraments this year. Once we know how many families are interested, then we can proceed immediately.

**RISE** –Is an Unprecedented Movement of Men. In its first year, RISE has transformed thousands of men’s lives all around the world. In the rare and exceptional cases where receiving Holy Communion in the hand poses a serious problem of conscience, you (Ministers of Holy Communion) may accommodate people by giving Communion on the tongue, by only after everyone else has received Communion on the hand. In any case, it is absolutely necessary to sanitize your hands before and after giving Communion” (Letter of August 4, 2020)
