Pope Francis is requesting that during this month of May the entire Church invoke the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary to the end of the pandemic and, in a special way, he is inviting all of us to pray fervently for those most closely affected by it.

During each day of May, guided by a calendar with specific intentions, all the Shrines around the world, united in a communion of supplications, will lift up their prayers, which, like the fragrance of incense, will rise up to heaven.

Thirty Marian Shrines will take turns leading this prayer throughout the Church and offering the faithful a series of prayer moments for them to participate throughout the entire day.

May 9th – Holy House of Loreto (Italia) – For all seniors

May 10th – Our Lady of Knock (Ireland) – For all people with disabilities

May 11th – Virgin of the Poor (Belgium) – For all the poor, the homeless, and the economically distressed

May 12th - Our Lady of Africa (Algeria) – For all people who live alone and those who have lost hope

May 13th – Blessed Virgin del Rosario (Portugal) – For all prisoners

May 14th – Our Lady of Health (India) – For all scientists and medical research institutions

May 15th – Our Lady Queen of Peace (Bosnia) – For all migrants

Let us pray for the end of pandemic united in the recitation of the Holy Rosary together with the Shrines around the world.

Kashub Day and Polish Day: The first Saturday in May is called Kashub Day. It is a celebration of the unique Kashub culture present in the Ottawa Valley. Polish Day is observed annually on May 3rd, to commemorate Poland's famous May 3rd Constitution of 1791 and celebrate the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Queen of Poland. Sadly, this year, we will not be able to publicly gather for either one of these events.
