The Body of Christ. Amen. This little "piece of bread" IS really and truly the omnipotent God of the universe. Amen! I am filled with amazement and awe. More wondrous still, in this mystery the infinite God gives Himself without diminution, drawing creation into His own inexhaustible life. Amen! Before this sacred Presence, I bow in adoration and thanksgiving. Amen!

The Body of Christ. Amen. This is the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus, the Son of God who said: "This is my Body. Take and eat." Amen! Here heaven and earth meet, and the ordinary gifts of creation are revealed as bearers of divine glory. Amen! This is the sacrifice of Christ made present among us, the gift of divine love poured out for the life of the world. Amen!

The Body of Christ. Amen. This is who I am as a Christian: "Receive who you are! Become what you receive." Amen! I will accept the call to be Christ for others! Amen! For in receiving Christ, I am invited ever more deeply into the communion of love that is the very life of God. Amen! Through this encounter with the living Lord, may my mind, heart, and life be transformed into His likeness. Amen!

The Body of Christ. Amen. This is the Whole Christ: Christ in His Body, in His brothers and sisters, especially in the poor and suffering. Amen! I will open my heart to Christ in His many guises! Amen! No one is a stranger to this mystery, for Christ gathers all humanity toward His eternal kingdom. Amen! The love I receive at this altar must become love lived in the world. Amen!

The Body of Christ. Amen. This is the sacrament of unity and Christ-like love, a call to forgiveness and unity, the challenge to become, like Jesus, a servant with basin and towel. Amen! In this holy feast every wall of division is judged and overcome, and we are summoned into the reconciliation of all things in Christ. Amen! Gathered into one Body, we are sent forth as witnesses of His truth, mercy, and peace. Amen!

The Body of Christ. Amen. In this sacred mystery, creation itself is offered back to God and returned transfigured with divine life. Amen! Here we taste the joy for which the world was made and anticipate the banquet of the Kingdom where God shall be all in all. Amen! Strengthened by this heavenly food, may I carry Christ into the world and help reveal His Kingdom already at work among us. Amen!

The Body of Christ: In the Communion dialogue, the Church proclaims the Mystery of Faith: Christ is truly present in the Eucharist and that His saving death, resurrection, and future coming are made present sacramentally.

Amen: The communicant personally assents to the Mystery of Faith and therefore receives Christ in faith with fruitfulness. "Amen" comes from a Hebrew word meaning "firm," "true," "reliable," or "so be it."
